

**FIFTH SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT ON ACTIVITIES OF
THE PARLIAMENT OF MONTENEGRO**

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I INTRODUCTION

MANS is implementing the project under the title "Improving of parliamentary monitoring and accountability in Montenegro", supported by the United Nations Democracy Fund (UNDEF). The project refers to monitoring transparency and activities of the Parliament of Montenegro and its MPs. Duration of the project is two years and five months, and this is the fifth and last report published by MANS, which relates to the period from January 1, 2020, to May 31, 2020.

On the basis of results of the parliamentary elections held on October 16, 2016, the Democratic Party of Socialists (DPS) won 36 seats, Democratic Front (DF) 18, coalition Ključ 9, Democratic Montenegro (DCG) 8, the Bosniak Party (BS) and the Social Democrats (SD) two seats, Albanians Decisively and the Croatian Civic Initiative (HGI) one each, while the Social Democratic Party (SDP) won 4 seats.

The Parliament of Montenegro was formed on November 7, 2016. Out of 81 MPs in Montenegro's Parliament, 42 elected the president and vice-presidents of the Parliament - Ivan Brajović, Branimir Gvozdenović and Genci Nimanbegu. Thus, the parliamentary majority consists of DPS, SD, and minority parties of Bosniaks, Albanians and Croats, while 39 opposition MPs (DF, Democratic Montenegro, SD, DEMOS, SNP and Civic movement URA) have agreed to boycott the Parliament of Montenegro.

Majority of Montenegrin opposition ended the boycott of the work of the Parliament that occurred due to parliamentary elections held on October 16, 2016. The opposition claimed they had not been held in a democratic atmosphere. Namely, on the election day, it was announced that the attempt of "coup" had taken place, which, according to the opposition parties, influenced the decision of the citizens and the election result. The opposition requested to repeat parliamentary elections as a condition to end the boycott. In this report as well, the work of the Parliament was boycotted by 9 opposition MPs of Democratic Montenegro and URA.

This report provides information on individual activities of MPs, most active MPs at the plenary sessions and MPs who did not request to speak at the plenary sessions. The work of MPs Groups, the work of MPs at the plenary sessions of the Parliament, as well as the control function of the Parliament were analysed.

The most active MP in the observed period was Raško Konjević (SDP), whose activity index was 2.26, while 13 MPs (Mirsad Murić, Maja Bakrač, Miodrag Vuković, Filip Vuković, Branko Čavor, Milorad Vuletić, Nikola Divanović, Zvonko Vuković, Žana Filipović, Veljko Vasiljević, Aleksandra Vujičić, Džavid Šabović and Nedžad Drešević) had an activity index of 0.00, which means that they had no activity at the plenum.

In the period from January 1 to May 31, 2020, two plenary sessions were held, while two sittings started in this time period but have not ended, they are in progress and will be continued in the following period. These four sittings of the Parliament, which were observed in this period, lasted 59 hours. MPs Group of DPS had most discussions, 99, while individually, Raško Konjević had most discussions, 19.

II ABSTRACT

In the past five months, the Parliament worked less intensely compared to the previous reporting period (May 1, 2019 - December 31, 2019), although MPs of part of the opposition, 9 of them, continue to boycott the work of the Parliament.

From January 1 to May 31, 2020, 2 plenary sessions were held, while two sittings started in this time period but have not ended, they are in progress and will be continued in the following period. At the mentioned sessions of the Parliament observed in this period, 15 laws and other legislation were discussed.

In the reporting period, MPs spent 7 working days at the plenum or a total of 59 hours, with the longest work in May - less than 4 working days, and the shortest in March - less than 5 hours.

In this period, a decrease in the activity of MPs during plenary sessions was noticed compared to the previous reporting periods. Only one MP actively participated in the work of the plenum, 17% of MPs were medium active, while as many as 82% were rarely active, and belong to inactive group of MPs when it comes to work at the plenary sessions.

The most active MP in this period was Raško Konjević from the Social Democratic Party (SDP), who is also the only MP in the group of active MPs.

Among MPs Groups, the most active were members of SD and LP MPs Group, followed by SDP, while SNP-DEMOS MPs Group is in the third place. DF is in the fourth place, while Special MPs Group is in the fifth place according to activity. It is followed by MPs Group of minority parties, while the most numerous MPs Group - DPS, is in the last place.

As of October 1, 2018, recording of the activities of MPs by topics has been carried out and it is a summing up of the total work of MPs by agenda items whose area/topic was previously defined. All items on the agenda are classified into three topics, divided into three categories: legal and political, economic, and social, which are further divided into subcategories, and the activities of MPs by topics are also classified within these categories.

When it comes to legal and political topics, the most active were Rasko Konjević, Jovanka Laličić, Halil Duković, Milorad Vuletić, Andrija Nikolić and Luid Škrelja. Boris Mugoša, Raško Konjević, Filip Vuković, Genci Nimanbegu and Petar Ivanović had most discussions on economic topics. In the end, MPs Andrija Popović, Raško Konjević, Aleksandar Damjanović and Branka Tanasijević paid most attention to social topics.

In order to improve day-to-day communication between citizens and MPs, NGO MANS developed a mobile application "Ask MPs" for all mobile platforms, and from January 1 to May 31 this year, citizens sent 20 questions to their representatives in the Parliament of Montenegro, and received answer to 8 questions.

Branka Bošnjak, MP from DF, received most questions (three), while MP from SD and LP MPs Group, Boris Mugoša. received two questions. Other MPs, 15 of them, received one question from the citizens each.

When it comes to answers of the MPs to citizens' questions, only 6 MPs actively provided answers (Branka Bošnjak, Andrija Popović, Aleksandar Damjanović, Danijela Pavićević, Anka Vukićević and Valentina Minić), while 11 MPs did not provide an answer to the questions asked, and it can be said that they were not responsible when it comes to this activity.

The Parliament does not perform the control role actively, and in a few cases when the control mechanisms are used, concrete obligations of the executive authorities are often not precisely specified, and there is no system for monitoring their implementation. In the past five months, the Parliament's committees organized 7 consultative hearings, where 26 people were questioned, while there were no control hearings in this period.

During this reporting period, by using control mechanisms, 3 conclusions were adopted that are binding on the executive authorities and other institutions. The Parliament has no system of monitoring the implementation of conclusions, which significantly reduces its capacity to perform the constitutional duty when it comes to controlling the work of the executive authorities.

III METHODOLOGY

MPs ACTIVITY INDEX

Below is an overview of the methodology on the basis of which MANS monitors and analyses the activities of MPs at plenary sessions, as well as the methodology of classification and monitoring of implementation of the conclusions of the Parliament.

Activity Index (AI) implies summing up of the total work of MPs of the Parliament of Montenegro at the plenary sessions. This index shows for each MP individually whether, from the point of view of activities at the plenum, they justified the salary received by the taxpayers of Montenegro in order to represent the citizens in the Parliament.

It is especially important to note that MANS is certainly aware of the fact that the work of the MPs does not imply only his/her presence and discussion at the plenary sessions. In addition, MPs should perform other important tasks, such as analysing of legal projects, various research, drafting amendments, as well drafting legislation, participation in the work of committees, MPs groups and certainly work with voters, which does not have to be visible through activities at the plenary sessions.

In addition, it is a known fact that every presence of MPs at the sittings of the Parliament may not always be constructive and contribute to the quality of its work. However, it cannot be disputed that through the presence and participation in the work of the Parliament and the committees, as is the obligation prescribed by Article 55 of the Rules of Procedure¹, an MP expresses his/her attitude towards the institution in which he/she is working and towards the citizens who appointed him/her to that office.

This index certainly does not tend to, or can fully evaluate the quality of work of each MP, but intends to point out to this aspect of parliamentary duty. After all, citizens should be the ones to determine whether they are satisfied with the overall work of the MPs and decide on this in the elections.

The criteria for increasing the MP's activity index are the number of discussions, discussion comments, responses to discussion comments, responses, and grounded procedural reactions.

Parameters that reduce their activity index are the number of measures imposed due to violation of order at the Parliament sittings, the number of warnings, the number of bars from speaking and the number of dismissals from sessions.

The formula based on which the MP's activity index is obtained looks like this:

The numbers with which positive parameters that make up the activity index are multiplied are directly correlated with duration of presenting at the plenary sessions.

Number of discussions is multiplied with number 0.10, which represents duration of discussion of 10 minutes. Despite the fact that the discussions in debates last 5 minutes individually, the number 0.10 seemed adequate because there is a huge difference in the number of discussions that were used in principled and joint discussions (almost 96%) and the number of discussions in details (around 4%). In support of such parameters is the fact that a discussion of any kind requires much greater preparation than other types of presentation.

For comments on discussions, responses to comments, and responses, the multiplier is 0.03, which represents a duration of 3 minutes for each of the categories individually. Reaction for violation of the Rules of Procedure, only the grounded one, is multiplied with 0.01, since for this form of presenting the Rules of Procedure stipulates duration of 1 minute.

Activity index of MPs Groups is calculated by the arithmetic mean of the index of activities of MPs belonging to it.

ACTIVITY INDEX OF MPs BY TOPICS

The Activity Index of MPs by topics has been implemented since 01 October 2018 and it is a summary of the total work of MPs by agenda items whose area/topic was previously defined. All items on the agenda are divided into three topics, which are divided into three categories: legal and political, economic, and social, which are further divided into subcategories:

Any activity of an MP within the discussion on the agenda items whose area/topic was previously defined is further qualified based on whether the MP speaks on the topic of the agenda item. Thus, each statement of an MP during the debate is further multiplied by weighting coefficients: within topic, mostly within topic, mostly off topic, and off topic.

CONCLUSIONS

By using the mechanism of conclusions, at plenary sessions or through the work of committees, the Parliament may issue instructions to institutions on acting in a particular field. Based on the collected conclusions during this convocation of the Parliament, they are grouped into categories according to the degree of measurability, i.e. the way in which they can be monitored. On this basis, three categories of conclusions are distinguished:

1. *MEASURABLE CONCLUSIONS*: contain specific instructions or measures and specify the method in acting in particular field.
2. *PARTLY MEASURABLE CONCLUSIONS*: contain instructions and recommendations for improvement, but do not define specific measures. They lack explicitly stated guidelines for acting, so it is quite difficult to quantify the degree of implementation.
3. *NON-MESURABLE CONCLUSIONS*: note progress in a particular area and welcome the implemented items. They do not contain instructions or specific measures to be taken.

IV ACTIVITIES OF THE MPs AND THE PARLIAMENT

This chapter provides an overview of values of the MPs index, which shows their activity at the plenary sessions. In addition to the MPs index, the index of MP's groups as well as their amendment activity are also provided. According to activity, MPs are grouped into three categories: active, medium-active and inactive MPs. In addition to this, this chapter also contains information on the activity index of MP's Groups. In addition, statistics on the Parliament sittings, such as duration and types of items, are also presented, while at the very end there is a review of the control function of the Parliament, which includes control and consultative hearings, as well as review of conclusions.

1. ACTIVITIES OF THE MPs AND THE MPs GROUPS

1.1. MPs

According to their activity, the MPs are divided into three groups: active, medium-active and inactive. Members of the active group include MPs with activity index greater than 2.00, medium-active between 1.00 and 2.00, while the inactive group includes MPs with activity index less than 1.00. It is important to note that the tables do not include MPs who boycott the work of the Parliament. There is 9 such MPs and their names are listed in Annex 1 of this report.

Active MPs include those with activity index greater than 2.00. There was only one active MP in the observed period, Raško Konjević from SDP, with activity index 2.26.

The group of medium-active MPs includes those with activity index from 1.00 to 2.00. MPs Andrija Nikolić, Branka Bošnjak and Ranko Krivokapić lead in this group. Their index is 1.56, 1.48 and 1.37 respectively.

In this category, there are 3 MPs from DPS, SD and LP, and DF each, 2 MPs from SDP, and one MP from Special MPs Group.

The group of inactive MPs consists of those with activity index less than 1.00. There are 59 inactive MPs in the Parliament, of which 32 MPs from the most numerous MPs Group - DPS, followed by 14 MPs from DF, 4 MPs from MPs Groups SNP-DEMOS, Special MPs Group and BS, coalition “Albanians Decisively” and HGI each, and one MP from SDP.

As many as 13 MPs did not participate in discussions and activities at the plenary sessions of the Parliament in the observed period. When it comes to MPs who did not participate in the discussions, 9 are from DPS, two from DF, and one MP from SDP and MPs Group BS, coalition “Albanians Decisively” and HGI respectively.

AMENDMENTS

Amendments to draft laws and other types of legislation that the Parliament is considering are one of the possibilities guaranteed by the Rules of Procedure of the Parliament of Montenegro that are available to MPs in order to amend the proposed legislation.

MPs, as submitters of amendments, have several ways to use this opportunity. An MP can submit an amendment independently, but one amendment may also be signed by several MPs or even on behalf of the party to which they belong.

In the period from January 1 to May 31, 2020, there were 45 amendments at the sessions of the working bodies of the Parliament of Montenegro, of which one amendment was discussed at the plenary session and it was not adopted. Other amendments were not discussed because they refer to items within the 2nd Sitting of the Second Ordinary Session, which was not completed in this reporting period.²

² 2nd Sitting of the Second Ordinary Session in 2020 is still in progress, and within it, MPs voted on only two items, while other items will be decided in the next course of the sitting.

Jovanka Laličić and Petar Ivanović, MPs of DPS MPs Group, submitted most amendments, 11. Branko Radulović, MP of DF MPs Group, submitted 10 amendments, while Aleksandar Damjanović of the Special MPs Group submitted 8 amendments.

Draginja Vuksanović Stanković of SDP submitted three amendments, as well as MPs from the Special MPs Group, Goran Danilović and Goran Radonjić.

MPs of DPS, Predrag Sekulić, Nikola Rakočević and Momčilo Martinović, and MPs of DF, Andrija Mandić, Milan Knežević and Nebojša Medojević, submitted two amendments each. One amendment submitted MPs of SDP, as well as MPs Andrija Mandić, Milan Knežević, Nebojša Medojević and Danijela Pavićević. MPs Srđan Milić, Danijela Pavićević and MP of DF, Branka Bošnjak, also submitted one amendment each.

Raško Konjević, MP of SDP, submitted one amendment that was not accepted at the plenary discussion.

Goran Danilović and Goran Radonjić, MPs of Special MPs Group, submitted five conclusions related to an agenda item of the 2nd Sitting of the Second Ordinary Session.

Compared to the previous semi-annual reports, there is a decrease in the number of amendments submitted by MPs, but there is a significant decline in the number of amendments compared to the previous convocations of the Parliament, suggesting that the MPs are insufficiently involved in correction of legal solutions of the Government.

1.2. MPs GROUPS

In the observed period, the largest activity index within the MPs groups had SD and LP MPs Group, 1.21. Next is SDP whose activity index is 1.19, while in the third place is SNP-DEMOS MPs Group whose index is 0.67. The activity index of DF is 0.64, of Special MPs Group 0.62, while MPs Group BS, coalition “Albanians Decisively” and HGI has index 0.44. Last is the most numerous MPs Group - DPS, whose index is 0.36.

Total number of discussions was 306, out of which DPS had 99. Most of the comments in the observed period had DF who used this MPs' right 22 times.

DF is followed by SNP-DEMOS with 12 comments. Total number of responses to comments was 66, and most of them had DPS - 35, while the MP's group BS, coalition "Albanians Decisively" and HGI had no responses to comments.

Number of MPs' reactions for violation of the Rules of Procedure amounted to 360, majority of which by SD and LP MPs Group, 92. There were total of 19 responses, of which DPS had 12, SDP 4, while DF had 2 responses. SNP-DEMOS MPs Group had one response, while SD and LP MPs Group, Special MPs Group and MPs Group of BS, coalition "Albanians Decisively" and HGI, had no responses in the observed period of the Parliament's work.

1.3. ACTIVITIES OF FEMALE MPs

Number of female MPs from MPs Groups who participated in the work of the Parliament of Montenegro in this reporting period was 22. The most active in this category was Branka Bošnjak from DF whose index is 1.48. Draginja Vuksanović Stanković from SDP is in second place with activity index 1.14, while Aleksandra Vuković from DPS is in third place with activity index 0.69.

In this group, there are 13 MPs from DPS, 5 MPs from DF, 2 from Special MPs Group and one MP from SDP and SNP-DEMOS MPs Group respectively. In addition to taking first places in this category, 2 female MPs are also included in the group of medium-active MPs in the period from January 01 to May 31, 2020. Activity index of other MPs from this group is below 1.00, which places them in the category of inactive MPs. Based on the above, it can be concluded that activity of female MPs in this period was significantly lower compared to previous reporting periods on the activity of MPs in the Parliament of Montenegro.

1.4. ACTIVITIES OF YOUNG MPs

In the category of young MPs in the Parliament of Montenegro belong the ones of up to 35 years of age. All MPs in this category are from DPS MPs Group, while in other MPs Groups that participate in the work of the Parliament there are no MPs younger than 35 years of age.

During the observed period from January 01 to May 31, 2020, the most active among young MPs was Nikola Rakočević, whose index is 1.28. He is followed by Andrija Nikolić and Mihailo Anđušić, whose index is 1.56 and 0.77 respectively. In addition to being first in this category, Nikola Rakočević and Andrija Nikolić also belong to the group of medium-active MPs in the period from January 01 to May 31, 2020. Activity index of the remaining MPs from this group is below 1.00, thus they belong to the group of inactive MPs.

2. ACTIVITIES OF MPs BY TOPICS

As of October 1, 2018, calculation of the activities of MPs by topics has been implemented and it is a summary of the total work of MPs by agenda items whose area/topic was previously defined. All items on the agenda are classified into three topics, which were divided into three categories: legal and political, economic, and social, which are further divided into subcategories, and the activities of MPs by topics are also classified within these categories. Below is an overview of the activity index of MPs by topics from 01 October, 2018, to 31 May, 2020.

2.1. Legal and political topics

Indices of activity of MPs within legal and political topics are divided into seven subcategories: anti-corruption, judiciary, human rights, public administration, security/defence, international relations and elections.

The most active MP when it comes to items on the agenda related to the anti-corruption is Raško Konjević, who also ranks first in the category of topics related to public administration and elections. He was also among the most active MPs within the topics devoted to judiciary, security and defence, and international relations. In second place is Ivan Brajović, while Daliborka Pejović is in third. Among the most active in this category, besides the mentioned MPs, were also Aleksandar Damjanović and Ranko Krivokapić.

In the area of judiciary, Jovanka Laličić spoke most, followed by MPs Miloš Nikolić, Danijel Živković and Predrag Sekulić from DPS.

When it comes to human rights topics, the most active MPs are Halil Duković, Andrija Popović, Ervin Ibrahimović, Suad Numanović and Momčilo Martinović.

In the area of public administration, in addition to Raško Konjević, Marta Šćepanović, Jovanka Laličić, Boris Mugoša i Andrija Popović were also active.

The most dedicated to items on the agenda related to security and defence were Milorad Vuletić, Genci Nimanbegu, Aleksandar Damjanović and Andrija Nikolić.

Finally, the most active MPs on the topics of international relations are Andrija Nikolić, Branko Radulović, Raško Konjević, Dragutin Papović and Ivan Brajović.

In the area related to the elections, besides Raško Konjević, the most active was Luid Škrelja, followed by Ivan Brajović, Branka Bošnjak i Nikola Rakočević.

Below is a table showing the most active MPs on legal and political topics, while the complete overview of the activities of all MPs within this topic is provided in Annex 4.

2.2. Economic topics

Economic topics are divided into seven sub-categories: transport/infrastructure, public finances, energetics, tourism, agriculture, ecology and spatial planning.

Within economic topics, the most discussed was the public finances, and the most active MP was Raško Konjević. He was also among most active MPs in topics related to transport and infrastructure, ecology and spatial planning.

Boris Mugoša, Andrija Popović, Milorad Vuletić and Predrag Sekulić were active when it comes to topics on traffic and infrastructure, while Aleksandar Damjanović, Predrag Sekulić, Branko Radulović, and Ana Nikolić were also active on the topic of public finance, in addition to Raško Konjević.

Filip Vuković talked most about energetics, followed by Branko Radulović, Strahinja Bulajić, Predrag Sekulić and Sanja Pavićević.

Predrag Sekulić is among most active in the fields of transport and infrastructure, public finances and energetics, while Petar Ivanović is among most active in the fields of tourism, agriculture, and ecology and spatial planning. Branko Radulović was among most active in the areas of public finance, energetics and ecology and spatial planning.

The topic of tourism was most discussed by Genci Nimanbegu and Petar Ivanović, followed by Nikola Rakočević, Momčilo Martinović and Marta Šćepanović.

Although agriculture was least discussed area at the plenary sessions of the Parliament, Petar Ivanović and Strahinja Bulajić were the most active, followed by Goran Danilović, Ervin Ibrahimović and Nedeljko Rudović. Petar Ivanović is ranked first in the field of ecology and spatial planning, followed by Raško Konjević, Sanja Pavićević, Branko Radulović and Aleksandar Damjanović.

Table 11 shows the most active MPs on economic topics, and a complete overview of the activities of all MPs in this area is provided in Annex 5.

2.3. Social topics

Social topics are divided into six sub-categories: culture, employment, healthcare, social protection, education and science, media and NGOs.

When it comes to topics classified as social topics, MPs paid most attention to healthcare, and least to the media and NGOs.

Draginja Vuksanović Stanković was among the most active in the field of healthcare, social protection, education and science, as well as the media and NGOs, and Branka Bošnjak was active in the topics of employment, healthcare, and education and science. Saud Numanović was among the most active in the areas of employment, healthcare and social protection.

Andrija Popović and Aleksandra Vuković discussed most about the culture, as well as MPs Ranko Krivokapić, Momčilo Martinović and Aleksandar Damjanović.

The most active on the topic of employment was Raško Konjević, followed by Anka Vukičević, Aleksandar Damjanović, Branka Bošnjak and Suad Numanović.

In the field of healthcare, the most active were Raško Konjević, followed by Branka Bošnjak, Draginja Vuksanović Stanković and Halil Duković.

MPs Aleksandar Damjanović, Raško Konjević, Suad Numanović, Boris Mugoša and Draginja Vuksanović Stanković paid most attention to social protection, while Branka Tanasijević, Andrija Popović, Radule Novović and Branka Bošnjak paid most attention to education and science, in addition to the already mentioned MP Draginja Vuksanović Stanković who was active on this topic as well.

The media and NGOs topic was most discussed by Branka Tanasijević and Andrija Nikolić, followed by Radule Novović and Mihailo Anđušić.

The table below shows the most active MPs on social topics, and a complete overview of the activities of all MPs in this area is provided in Annex 6.

3. ACTIVITIES OF THE MPs WITHIN MOBILE APP "ASK MPs"

In order to improve day-to-day communication between citizens and MPs, NGO MANS developed a mobile application "Ask MPs" for all mobile platforms, as foreseen by implementation plan of this project.

"Ask MPs" application allows citizens to send messages with information on issues in free and open format and communicate with them on various topics, while at the same time, MPs are able to provide answers by using the same application. This allows citizens to assess their level of satisfaction with communication with a particular MP, but also to indicate whether the answer was provided by other methods (e.g. e-mail, direct meeting, etc.). This will also provide significant benefit to all MPs who will be able to work more effectively with larger number of citizens and potentially attract new voters. "Ask MPs" app allows MPs to be more accountable and open in their constituencies, while it provides citizens with effective communication channels to report their issues to MPs of their choice.

From January to May this year, citizens sent 20 questions to their representatives in the Parliament of Montenegro, of which 8 questions were answered.

In the observed period, citizens sent five questions to the MPs of DF, four questions to the MPs of the Special MPs Group, while they sent three questions each to DPS and SD and LP MPs Group. MPs Group BS, coalition "Albanians Decisively" and HGI received one question, while citizens sent one question each to SDP, SNP-DEMOS and Democrats.

It can be seen from the previous table that three questions were addressed to the MP of DF parliamentary club, Branka Bošnjak, two questions to MP of SD and LP MPs Group, Boris Mugoša, while 15 MPs received one question each.

When it comes to answers of the MPs to citizens' questions, only 6 of them (Branka Bošnjak, Andrija Popović, Aleksandar Damjanović, Danijela Pavićević, Anka Vukićević and Valentina Minić) actively provided answers, while 11 MPs did not provide a single answer to the questions asked, and it can be said that they were not responsible when it comes to this activity.

4. SITTINGS OF THE PARLIAMENT

In the period from January 1 to May 31, 2020, two plenary sessions were held, while two sittings started in this period but did not finish and will continue in the following period. Namely, First Sitting of the Second Ordinary Session and Third Special Sitting in 2020 were held, while Second Sitting of the Second Ordinary Session and Fourth Special Sitting are still in progress.

Within these four plenary sessions, there was a total of 15 agenda items.

4.1. OVERVIEW OF SITTINGS

An overview of the agenda items of all sittings is given in the table below.

There were 15 items on the agenda in the observed period, of which 5 items were adopted.³ Out of the total number of items, 1 concerned the Prime Minister's Hour and MPs questions, and they are not voted on at the sittings of the Parliament of Montenegro, while two referred to the elections and appointments. Within items referring to elections and appointments, one sub-item was discussed.⁴

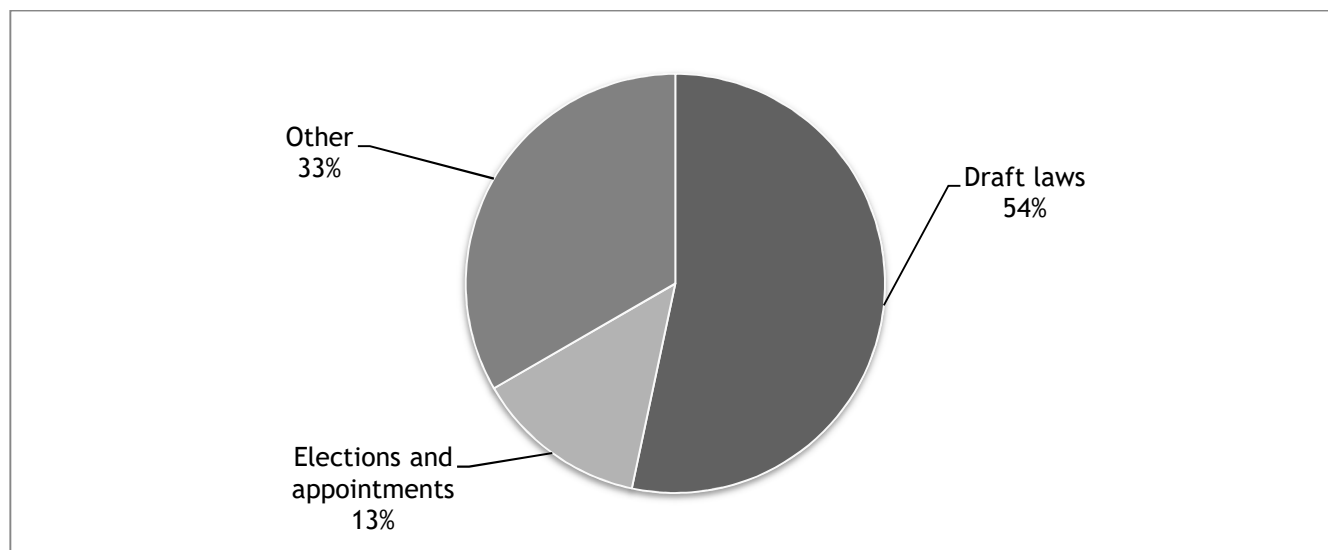
4.2. AGENDA

In the observed period, draft laws were most frequently discussed, and they were on the agenda 8 times. They are followed by the item elections and appointments, which were on the agenda twice.

Below is a list of agenda items discussed most frequently at the sittings of the Parliament. The group named "other" includes Prime Minister's Hour, Prime Minister's Hour and MPs questions, Draft Law on the Ratification of the Protocol, Draft Law on Ratification of the Agreement, Information. These topics were 5 times on the agenda at the sittings of the Parliament.

³ Second Sitting of the Second Ordinary Session in 2020 is still in progress, and within it, MPs voted on only two items, while other items will be decided in the next course of the sitting.

⁴ Within the Second Sitting of the 2nd Ordinary Session, the item Elections and Appointments was only started but not completed by May 31, 2020, as well as the item Prime Minister's Hour and MPs questions within the 4th Special Sitting in 2020.

According to data presented, most frequently discussed were draft laws, which were on the agenda 8 times. They are followed by discussions on elections and appointments, while the Prime Minister's Hour, Prime Minister's Hour and MPs' questions, Draft Law on Ratification of the Agreement, Draft Law on Ratification of the Protocol and Information were discussed once during this reporting period.

In the observed period, 5 items of the agenda were adopted. Three items were adopted at the 1st Sitting of the Second Ordinary Session in 2020, Draft Law on Ratification of the Agreement, Draft Law on Ratification of the Protocol, and one sub-item within the item Elections and appointments. Within 2nd Sitting of the Second Ordinary Session in 2020, which has not ended yet, the MPs adopted two draft laws, while the other items will be voted on in the next course of the session.

In the observed period, two Special Sittings of the Parliament of Montenegro⁵ were organized which were dedicated to the Prime Minister's Hour and MPs' questions. At these sitting, the Prime Minister was asked 14 questions by MPs, while 14 MPs' questions were addressed to representatives of the Government, to which they gave answers.⁶

4.3. DURATION OF SITTINGS

In the period from January 1 to May 31, 2020, two plenary sessions were held, while two sessions started during this period but did not end, they are in progress and will be continued in the following period. These four sittings of the Parliament, which were observed in this period, lasted 59 hours.

2nd sitting of the II Ordinary session lasted longest, 43 hours, and it will continue in the following period, while the 3rd Special Sitting in 2020 lasted 4 hours. Items on the agenda on the 2nd sitting of the II Ordinary session were draft laws, elections and appointments, and information.

Third Special Sitting in 2020 contained an item dedicated to the Prime Minister's Hour, while the 4th Special Sitting in 2020, which is in progress, is dedicated to the Prime Minister's Hour and MPs questions.

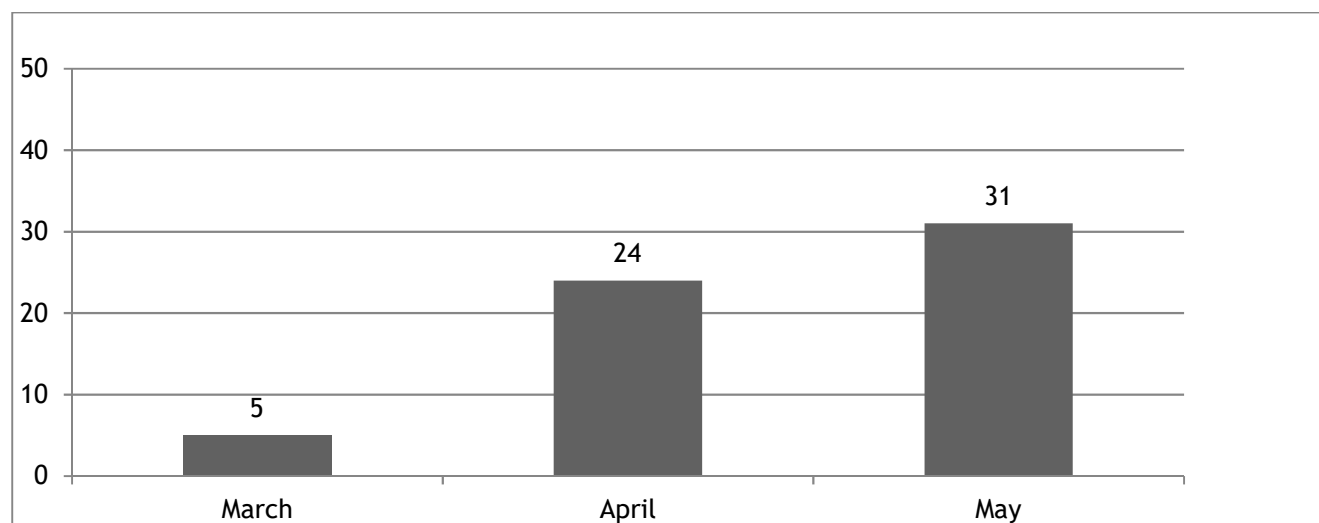

5. CONTROL FUNCTION OF THE PARLIAMENT

Besides its legislative function, the Parliament of Montenegro has the obligation to control the work of the executive authorities. In order to carry out its control function efficiently, the Parliament has at its disposal a set of mechanisms⁷ to request from the executive authorities to provide information, but also to recommend or impose the implementation of specific activities in order to overcome certain issues.

5.1. USE OF CONTROL MECHANISMS

Control hearing is a mechanism of the Parliament of Montenegro for controlling the work of other branches of the government and independent institutions supervised by the Parliament, which checks the current or past situation or activity in a particular area or institution, and provides guidance for improvement through opinions and conclusions.

Consultative hearing is more of advisory than the control activity that the Parliament uses in order to collect, from various subjects in society, various types of information or stances on certain law, appointment, occurrence or work of a particular institution, including those that are not subject to supervision of the Parliament.

In the period from January 1 to May 31, 2020, working bodies of the Parliament organized 7 consultative hearings, while no control hearings were conducted in this period.⁸

In above mentioned meetings, 23 people were questioned, divided into two groups, so the first one consisted of 14 representatives of the ministries, while the second group named "others" had 12 persons in total.

The group "others" consists of representatives of the State Prosecutor's Office, the Armed Forces of Montenegro, public administrations, associations, commissions, municipalities. Annex 6 contains information on all persons who took part at hearings, as well as persons who participated in the consultative hearings in this reporting period.⁹

⁷ The Parliament may organize consultative and control hearings and a parliamentary inquiry to obtain all relevant information about a case or occurrence. Moreover, by submitting an Interpellation on the work of an executive body, MPs may address specific issues and give their conclusions that are binding for the executive authorities. The Prime Minister's Hour and MPs' questions are also a way in which MPs can perform the control function, asking questions to the Prime Minister and other representatives of the executive authorities, who are obliged to answer them.

⁸ One control and two consultative hearings were scheduled for March, but were postponed due to coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) and prescribed measures by the competent institutions, and will be held in the following period.

⁹ Annex 6 does not include some persons who participated in the consultative hearing of the Committee on Tourism, Agriculture, Ecology and Spatial Planning held on March 11, 2020, because the documentation from that hearing was not published on the website of the Parliament of Montenegro during preparation of this report.

5.2. CONCLUSIONS

In the period from January 1 to May 31, 2020, a total of 3 conclusions, of which 1 measurable and 2 partly conclusions were published on the website of the Parliament and in the Official Gazette of Montenegro, and all were adopted at sessions of the working bodies of the Parliament. There were no non-measurable conclusions in this observed period.

Two conclusions (one measurable and one partly measurable) were adopted in this period, but refer to the control hearings held in the previous reporting period (from 1 May to 31 December 2019). Both conclusions were processed in this report as announced in the previous report.

After a consultative hearing held on March 11, 2020, the Committee on Tourism, Agriculture, Ecology and Spatial Planning announced the adoption of a conclusion that has not yet been published on the website of the Parliament of Montenegro, thus, it is not processed in this report.

All processed conclusions in this reporting period refer to the ministries in the Government of Montenegro, while one conclusion, in addition to being related to the ministries, also refers to the Protector of Human Rights and Freedoms.

Two conclusions refer to the Ministry of Labour and Social Welfare, the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Human and Minority Rights, while one refers to the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of Public Administration, the Ministry of Transport and Maritime Affairs, the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, the Ministry of Sustainable Development and Tourism and the Protector of Human Rights and Freedoms of Montenegro.

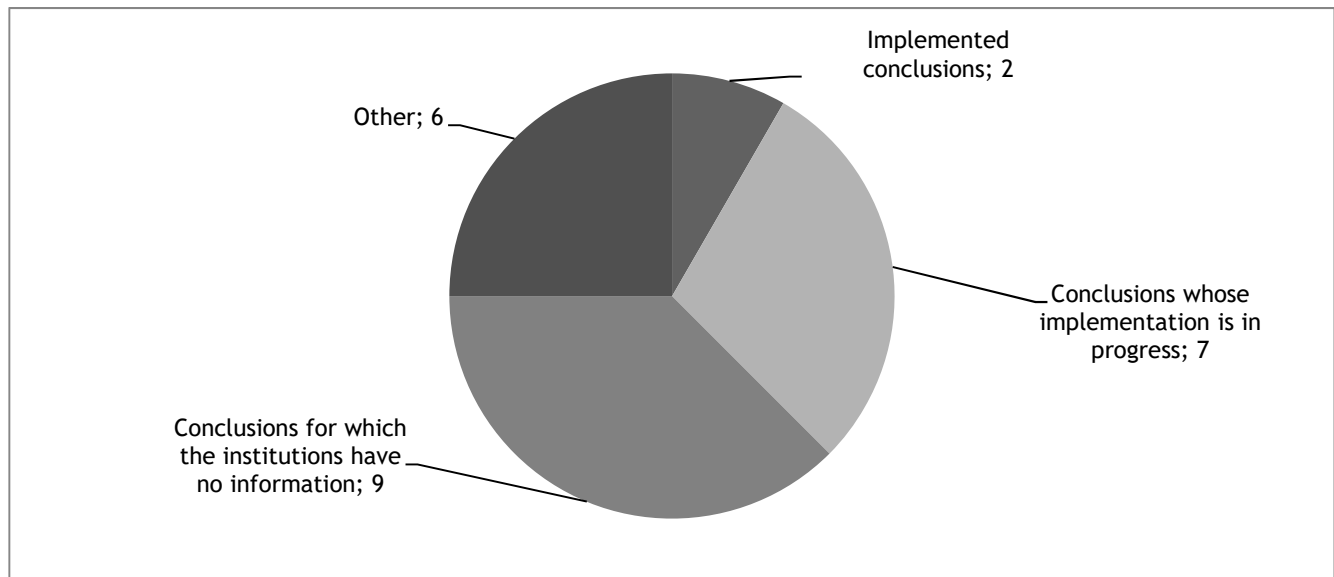

5.3. IMPLEMENTATION OF CONCLUSIONS

Bearing in mind that the Parliament does not have developed mechanism for monitoring its own conclusions, and therefore does not have data on the degree of implementation, i.e. whether they have been acted upon at all, within this project, through free access to information, MANS collected data from institutions on the implementation of conclusions of the Parliament to whose work they relate.

MANS collected data for 24 conclusions that are measurable and partly measurable, and relate to the conclusions adopted from May 1 to December 31, 2019. Accordingly, 52 requests for free access to information were sent to institutions, of which access was allowed for 22 requests.



Graph no. 3: Status of implemented and partly implemented conclusions

Namely, the graph shows that only two conclusions have been implemented, and that the implementation of seven conclusions¹⁰ adopted by the Parliament is in progress, which were partly implemented at the time of sending the request for free access to information. However, for nine conclusions, the institutions to which the request for free access to information on the implementation of the conclusions was sent, either did not have information, rejected the request or the data were marked under business label "secret".

The group marked "other" includes six conclusions for which the institutions allowed access to information. However, for three conclusions the institutions responded that a detailed overview of the implementation of the conclusions will be contained in the reports on their work for 2019 which will be submitted to the Parliament of Montenegro for consideration, while for three conclusions, the institutions stated that they would submit documentation on their implementation, but they did not do that in the period of preparation of this report.

¹⁰ Two requests for free access to information sent to institutions related to the implementation of two conclusions were rejected, but the reasonings stated that the implementation and enforcement of conclusions in strategic documents is underway, thus, these two conclusions are classified into the group of conclusions under implementation.
