Izvištaji o prihodima i imovini. Takođe, valja ukazati da tužena paušalno i proizvoljno navodi da je za imenovanog javnog funkcionera izvršena provjera svih podataka po službenoj dužnosti i da u toku provjere nijesu utvrđena bilo kakva odstupanja sa podacima koji se vode u zvaničnim evidencijama drugih državnih organa, bez navođenja konkretnih podataka i bez davanja obrazloženja na koji način i kako je vršila provjeru i zašto se poziva samo na provjeru podataka iz izvištaja upoređivanjem tih podataka sa prikupljenim podacima o imovini i prihodima funkcionera kod organa vlasti, kod čijenege da je tužilac u zahtjevu naveo da je imenovani javni funkcioner i Upravi za nekretnine prijavio netačne i nepotpune podatke.

Sud je kao neosnovan ocijenio i prigovor tužene o nedostatku aktivne legitimacije, s obzirom da se ova vrsta postupaka pokreće i na zahtjev i pravni ili fizičkih lica, što je propisano u članu 31 stav 1 Zakona o sprečavanju korupcije, a članom 51 stav 1 Zakona o upravnom postupku propisano je da je stranka u upravnom postupku, između ostalih, fizičko ili pravno lice na čiji zahtjev je pokrenut upravni postupak. Stoga je sa svih navedenih razloga Sud tužbu usvojio i osporeno rješenje poništio.

U ponovnom postupku tuženi će imati u vidu primjedbu i nedostatke ukazane ovim rješenjem, pa će saglasno odredbi člana 56 Zakona o upravnom sporu, donijeti novo zakonito rješenje.

Odluka o troškovima spora zasnovana je na odredbama člana 152 Zakona o parničnom postupku u vezi sa članom 39 stav 2 Zakona o upravnom sporu, a

NGO MANS called on the *Council of the Agency for Prevention of Corruption (APC)* to immediately initiate the procedure for dismissal of the director *Jelena Perović* due to results that continuously discredit the anti-corruption reforms, and continue to ensure for individuals from the previous government to avoid responsibility for violating the law. In the period from September last year to February this year, the Administrative Court annulled several decisions of the APC by which this institution refused to deal with cases of illicit enrichment of senior public officials. **For more than half a year, the director of APC has refused to act on the rulings of the Administrative Court and reopen the cases of Đukanović's property in Kočani and expensive trips to Dubai and Saint Tropez.**

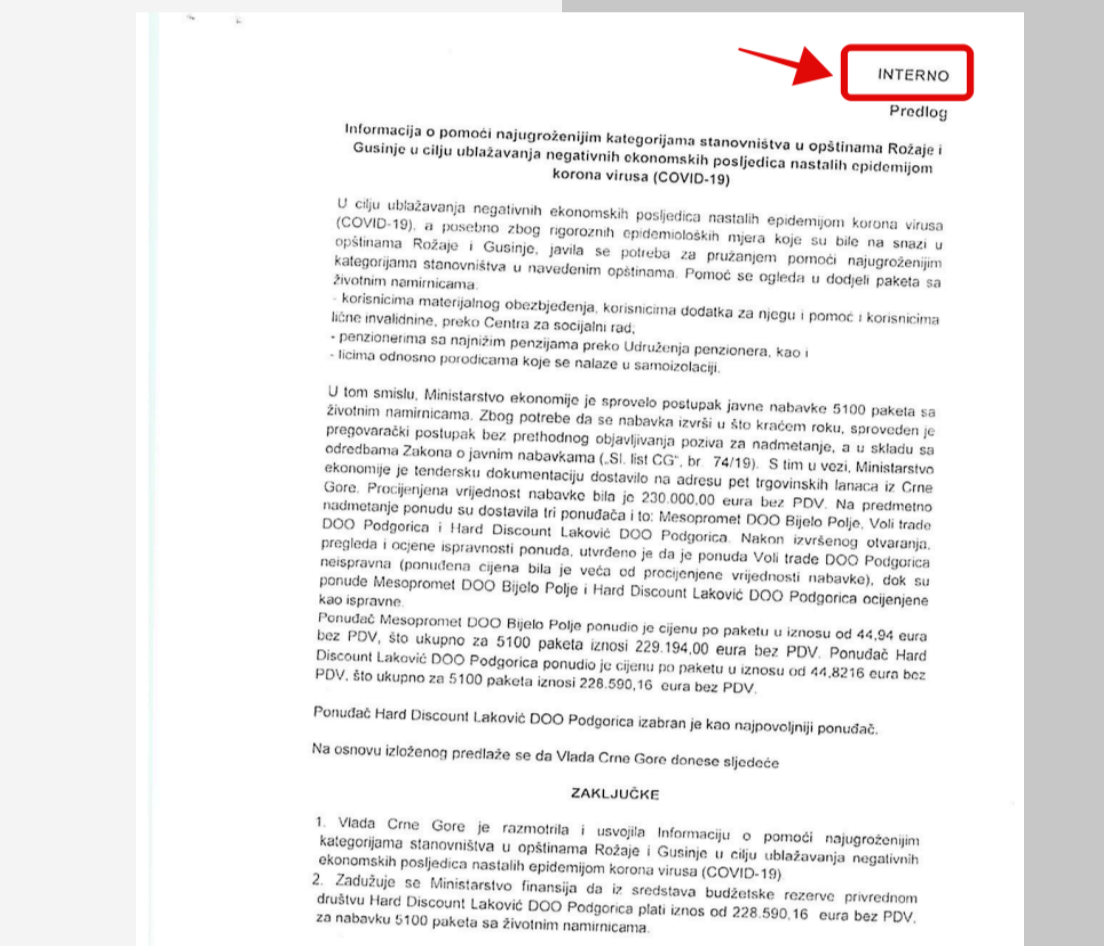

Although the current government has the right to audit the accounts of the concessionaire *Eni and Novatek*, with which the former government signed a contract in 2016, and which began exploratory oil and gas drilling in late March, the Ministry of Capital Investments does not intend to audit everything that has been done so far regarding this project, before it is determined whether there are reserves, i.e. before the production starts. On this occasion, NGO MANS states that it is quite certain that there is no political willingness in the Ministry to move away from the practice that has existed so far, and that they will continue to insist on a full audit of this agreement, with the help of relevant experts and maximum transparency of the entire procedure.

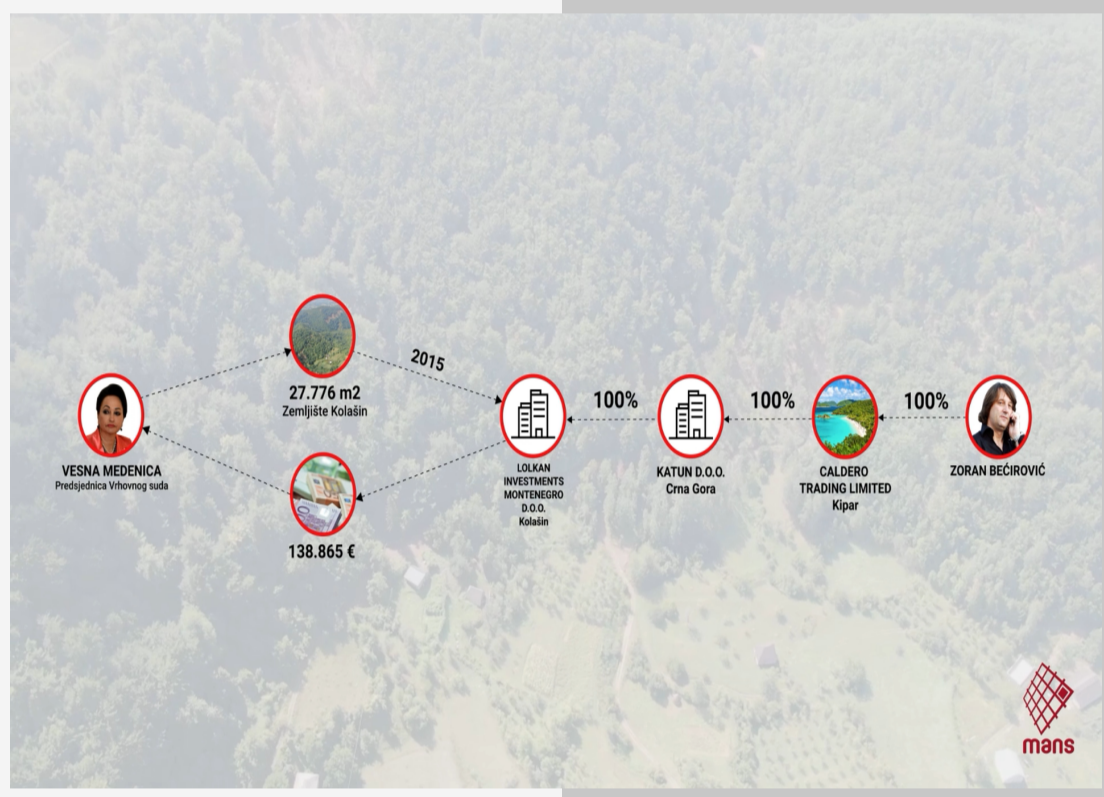

The investigative story that the Ministry of Economy distributed over 5,000 food packages a month before last year's parliamentary elections, is brought by a journalist from *Vijesti* with the support of MANS, as part of a project to support the investigative journalism. The value of the package that was distributed to the citizens on that occasion was close to 280,000 euros including VAT, and the amount was paid from the budget reserve. Under the pretext of the coronavirus pandemic, the whole deal was completed in just a few days, but the Ministry found time to declare the documentation secret. This information contained data on the amount of funds that were allocated from the state budget, as well as the fact that the public procurement was organized by urgent procedure and without a public call.

The latest data of the MANS Investigative Centre show that *Bećirović* used a company founded by his other company, *Caldero Trading Limited*, registered in Cyprus, to buy land from *Medenica*. Leaked banking data indicates that *Caldero Trading* was conducting transactions with an offshore company and two Baltic banks that found themselves at the centre of two networks that laundered huge amounts of money from Russia. Montenegro's judiciary and State Prosecutor's Office undoubtedly played a significant role in state capture of Montenegro, i.e. strengthening its political and interest influence on its institutions, which over time "learned" to subordinate the public interest to private, i.e. party interest. In the report "*State Capture: Montenegro National Report*", MANS investigated how to capture a state and maintain the state capture, highlighting the shortcomings of the criminal justice system in prosecuting large-scale corruption cases and exposing tailor-made laws designed and adopted to protect the private interests of a few people. 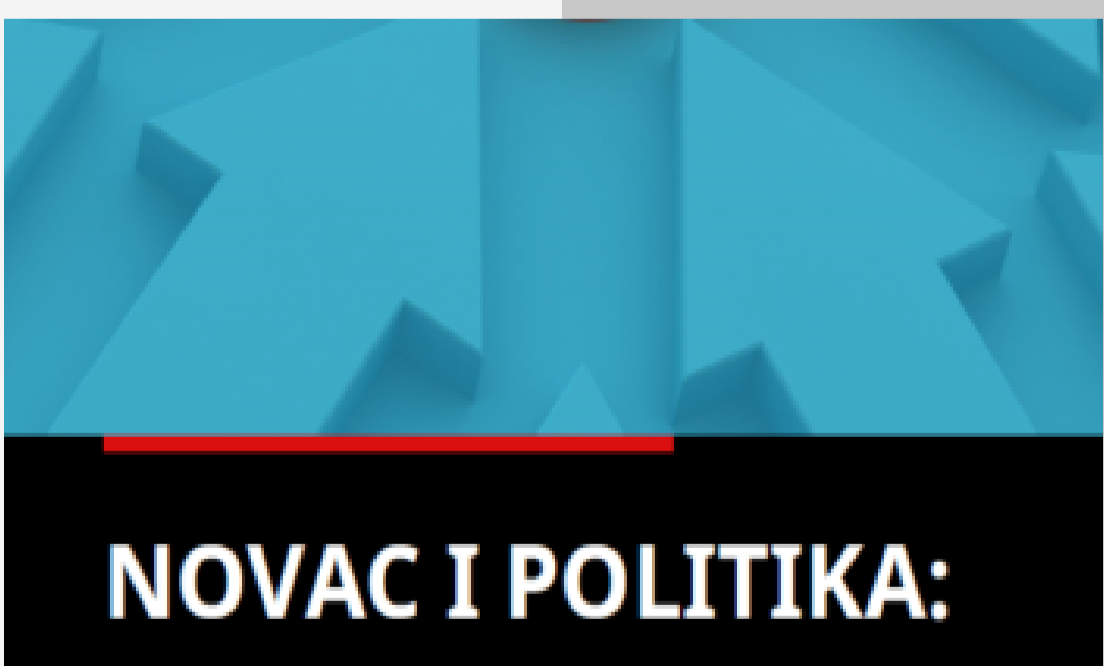

After more than six months and public criticism, the Ministry of Finance and Social Welfare responded to requests for free access to information from the NGO MANS, which related to budget spending after the election of the new Montenegrin government. MANS obtained this information by using the Law on Free Access to Information and by continuously reminding the Ministry of Finance of the obligation to comply with that law. The public has no information on how nearly half a million euros allocated from the budget was spent to finance the regular work of women's organizations of political parties. Although the parties were duly paid funds in 2020 to finance the regular work of women's organizations, almost no party submitted a report on the manner in which these funds were spent, even though they are obliged to do so according to the Law on Financing Political Entities.
